I am writing this letter to inform you of our support for the TRIOS platform.

We recently procured Steve's solution with PSIC and county funds to bring and link all of the cities and their respective agencies in our county together. All in all we have 15 cities and over 30 agencies that have connected their radio systems.

Steve Calabrese, the founder of the company worked with the Lake County engineers directly for over 6 months testing and verifying that the system did what he said it would do for us and even more. It did.

We have been running our system now with 800MHz EDACS talk groups connected to various UHF, VHF, and 800 MHz systems in FM and P25 mode for just over 1 year and it has performed flawlessly.

At first I was a bit skeptical because dealing with the 2-way radio companies and cross-band repeater companies; I thought I had heard it all before. I now strongly believe in Steve's vision to create a "community" of radio system users across the USA where any system, regardless of location, radio technology, or band can seamlessly connect nationwide.
